Hock, for example, says she had the good fortune of connecting with Greg Evans of Tuscan Hills, LLC, to locate a special wrought iron Mediterranean couch for the porch. “It's a perfect fit for my design. Even the orange cushions complement the earth tones of the containers and colors of the perennials I've used.” Evans, owner of Tuscan Hills, LLC, redesigned the sitting room into a “Green Room.” This is the room in a theater, studio or movie set where performers can rest in-between takes,” explains Evans.

To give the room a “star treatment,” Evans first added three signature pieces: a hand-forged wrought iron day bed, a hand-painted volcanic stone table and two “movie set” chairs, which just happen to sport the photos of Marilyn Monroe and Humphrey Bogart on the chair backs. “To pay tribute to the name of the room, we finished the walls with a light green wash. There is a gorgeous turquoise bed sheet on the day bed, a silver rug and silver light fixtures, and several other wrought iron pieces in the room. Every piece in the room is made in Italy—primarily Tuscany and Umbria,” says Evans.
